

“Ebola Prevention” Entry Quarantine Procedures

Chinese and English publicity broadcast on all flights
(Visitors who have traveled to the Ebola-affected areas in Western Africa 21 days prior to arrival in Taiwan should take the initiative to report to the airport quarantine officers.)

Distribute Ebola Declaration Cards (Blue Cards) on high-risk flights

Quarantine Officers
1. Collect Blue Cards
2. Assess, give health education, and give a Health Care Card (Yellow Card)
3. Create a file for surveillance

Quarantine Officers
1. Collect Blue Cards
2. Re-take temperature and assess

Quarantine Officers
1. Re-take temperature
2. Assess and give health education

Return Blue Cards at the National Immigration Agency’s passport check counters.

Immediately/Subsequently send to a hospital for examination

Implement quarantine measures on a case-by-case basis.

National Immigration Agency
1. Identify visitors who are citizens of Ebola-affected countries.
2. Check those who tick “YES” on their Blue Cards.

1. Visitors should conduct independent health monitoring for 21 days, with the health authority keeping track every day.
2. Subsequently send to a hospital for examination when necessary.
